

## PEACE LINE. Peace Ambassadors wanted

### Requested teamer profile

It will be necessary that you have some experience in accompanying (international) youth projects and/or in holding history workshops and seminars.

As a teamer, you will be responsible for the group during the route or Spotlight. The group will consist of 20 young adults from all over Europe with different backgrounds and opinions. We will be on the move a lot, so teamers who keep the group together and are available for questions are indispensable.

The individual places will be didacticised beforehand and prepared in such a way that the participants can learn about the contents together. They are supported in this by the teamers. The task of the teamers will be to adapt this material if needed, to conduct workshops, to take up questions, lead discussions and to moderate them in a goal-oriented way.

In order to be able to classify and comment on factually incorrect opinions of participants, it is important that teamers can contextualise them with their own knowledge without acting in a lecturing manner. Therefore, sufficient historical knowledge about the topics is important. Basic knowledge is sufficient for the application, but until the start of the journey, the teamers need to deal intensively with the topics to be able to lead the workshops. The teamers will also have to take care of organisational tasks, such as checking whether everyone is on time, keeping track of the finances, social media, etc. The teamers will be trained by us in advance for these tasks.

As a teamer you can also be older than the participants but being close to the age of the participants is often helpful for the life on the journey together.

### Working conditions

There will be a prep meeting where you meet the other teamers and the PEACE LINE team. Afterwards, you will have more online meetings with the team and the consultant to talk about the route or Spotlight in detail. Some preparation work will be done by yourself at home, some together.

The PEACE LINE routes last 14-15 days, Spotlights last 6 days. Teamers need to arrive 2 days earlier, to make the last preparation steps together with the educational consultant. The work of the teamers ends with the end of the journey, except one follow-up evaluation meeting (online).

The teamers receive a financial remuneration for their work (€3,520 gross for a route and €1,540 gross for a Spotlight) and a travel allowance. The costs for accommodation, meals, entrance fees and visa are covered.

### Team composition

There are 26 participants and 4 teamers on a PEACE LINE route, each Spotlight group consists of 20 participants and 2 teamers.

As a teamer, you are responsible for conducting the programme. The PEACE LINE organisational team is available via phone and e-mail for every question.

### Application & selection procedure
